GUARDIANSHIP CLINIC

This *free* clinic is intended to educate participants about the Guardianship process, and will include:

- Educating participants about the legal requirements & procedures to obtain a guardianship (of the person);
- Providing free legal advice to clients (available to low-income qualifiers);
- Helping clients prepare their own pro-per guardianship documents for filing with the court;
- A “Self-Help” guardianship video produced by the courts;
- A guardianship presentation by a Pro Bono Attorney;
- *Free legal advice and assistance with guardianship document preparation.*

***The training is open to the public, but participants must meet CCLS’s Eligibility Requirements to receive free legal assistance. The class is filled on a “first come” basis.**
